Carbon Monoxide Hazard

Carbon Monoxide (CO) will cause serious injury or death. You can't see or smell CO, but you can stay away from the sources.

- ***** Swimmers: Stay clear of exhaust port(s) when motor(s) are running.
- ***** Be alert when running motors at anchor.
- ***** Be alert when motoring downwind.
- * Be alert when anchored or moored near someone running a motor.

Symptoms of CO poisoning include (in progressive order):

- Eye irritation
- Dizziness
- Headache
- Fatigue
- Difficulty thinking coherently
- Vomiting
- Seizure
- Collapse
- Death

Note: Death can occur without warning when sleeping in a CO laden environment, or very rapidly in high levels of CO.

"Evacuate, ventilate, investigate and take corrective action."—ABYC
